求學之途

徐醫生自小在聖伯多祿 這大家庭成長,同為伯多祿 傳人,他與我們的起跑線並 沒有任何不同。徐醫生能夠 學有所成,並非全憑天賦, 在他迢迢學途上亦有艱苦 波折,然而他卻從中汲取經 驗,愈挫愈勇,力臻至善。 他憶述:天有不測之風雲, 在他考升中試當天,恰逢 傾盆大雨,他始料不及,冒 雨趕赴考場,途中更不慎弄傷腿,因此在狼狽的狀態應考,期間又分神於傷口,狀態不佳,徐醫生未能獲得所期望之成績入讀聖伯多祿中學。他從中體會到事事應作充分準備,要為自己治「未病之病」,才可避免計劃趕不上變化,而令自己處於危難的局面,這道理適用於學習,同時亦是達成目標的關鍵和處世之道。值得我們學習的不僅是未雨綢繆的道理,還有徐醫生能在挫折中學習,汲取經驗的精神。一年後,他憑著毅力奮發向上,成功爭取轉回我校繼續學習。

杏林有感

徐醫生開診所執業逾廿八年,他認為從醫可以學以致用。「從醫是開心的,不會想停止的。」徐醫生指出所學習的醫科知識十分寶貴,能夠用自己的知識幫助病人,一方面會為自己在學習上掌握到知識而高興,另一方面會為病人獲得幫助而感安慰。從醫也是一門需要不斷學習的事業,隨著時代進步,醫學亦日新月異,因此自己需要不斷鑽研新醫學知識,尋找最適當的治療予病人,這亦算是盡己所能去幫助病人。

其次,徐醫生認為從醫工作既有趣,又有挑戰,很難令他厭倦。他經常接觸不同年齡、不同行業的人,聆聽他們分享工作或家庭事,像朋友般交流,讓他們建立亦醫亦友的關係。偶然還能認識新朋友,這是其他工作很難找到的經驗,所以徐醫生認為從醫有趣,並不沉悶。雖然徐醫生為病人治療的工作是嚴肅且嚴謹的,但他覺得問診時細心聆聽病人的分享,不但對了解他們的病情有裨益,更有助斷症,因為要留意病人一些細微的變化,方能對症下藥。若病情處於緊急狀態,更要與時間競賽,以其醫學知識應變,推斷出病源之所在,所以他認為從醫是頗具挑戰性的工作。

青年科學家計劃(Young Scientist Programme)



徐師兄在畢業之後,仍不忘投放時間精力於母校舊生會,作為伯多祿傳人,他覺得聖伯多祿中學是他第二個家,回到母校格外有親切感,而師兄也享受栽培學生的過程,他希望能夠為母校盡一分力。舊生會舉辦了青年科學家計劃的拔尖課程,以培育科普新一代的學子。徐師兄認為現時學生向上流動的機會較以往低,課程又較重視學生語文能力的培訓。遷到新校舍後,教學資源較以往充裕,所以舊生會投入資源舉辦青年科學家計劃的拔尖課程,讓學生能夠接觸平日難以見識的事物,透過科普範疇的拔尖計劃,照顧一些在語文能力上未盡善,但在科學領域上有天賦的學生,讓學生在未來選科時擁有更多的出路。

給師弟和師妹的話

所謂「修身、齊家、治國、平天下」,是《大學》提出彰顯明德的必經道路,要修身,則應「格物致知,誠意正心」。徐醫生認為這就是我們應該追求之事,我們在學校學的不應只是硬知識,更應是一種至善的學習態度以及明辨性思維。學習的第一步便是認真專注,深入研究課題有助我們打好基礎,繼而逐步深入理解。然後,我們應該學習明辨性思維,不應人云亦云,才能格物而致知。另外,我們亦應勤於學習,達到渴望追求知識的境界,不斷自我修正,這就是誠意,誠其求知之意,才可以正其心。先修身,從而循序漸進,達致大學之道,亦是我們在學校學習的目的。



Career Leaders Training



9-13 December

In 2014, Gatsby Foundations and Sir John Holman launched the Career Guidance report which outlined eight benchmarks showing 'good career guidance in schools' and was piloted in 16 schools in the North East of England. Remarkable outcomes and impacts were shown. With great efforts in lobbying and advocacy, the Gatsby Benchmarks have been placed at the heart of the Careers Strategy since then.

In collaboration with NGO teams, namely Hong Kong Children and Youth Services and Hong Kong Christian Service, and The Chinese University of Hong Kong, CLAP @ HKJC has worked with Sir John Holman and Ryan Gibson to co-create HK Benchmarks (#HKBM), a self-improvement

framework of world-class standard, to cater for the needs and landscape of Hong Kong.

St. Peter's is honoured to be invited to be one of the very first six pilot schools in Hong Kong. We will shoulder the mission of uncovering more about the benchmarks by attending various workshops and conferences both locally and in England, in hopes of applying them onto our school's Careers Guidance Planning, and sharing the essence of what we have procured and been inspired with other schools in Hong Kong.

A total of 17 teachers from six pilot schools were nominated to the Career Leaders Training. We took the first three modules in Hong Kong and completed the remaining modules in Newcastle, where we also visited schools to learn from their experience and ethical practices.



9th December 2019 Southmoor Academy

Southmoor strives to consistently support and engage every student to understand and develop their future pathway and to confidently raise and achieve their aspirations in an increasingly competitive and ever-changing world. Mr Simon Wareham and his team shared valuable insights on how to incorporate career education and guidance in our everyday curriculum.

12th December 2019 Castle View Enterprise Academy

Castle View is one of the 16 pilot schools for Gatsby Benchmarks. Their vision is to provide good quality independent and impartial careers advice to students which inspires them and motivates them to fulfill their potential. We enjoyed presentations from their Career Leaders, Ms Emma McDermott, and Ms Anna Bevan. Students led us for a through school tour, too.

Walker Riverside Academy

Walker Riverside Academy aims to provide all students with a stable careers programme where an opportunity is given to prepare for the transition into the evolutionary world of work. They intend to raise their aspirations, improve social mobility, develop 8 employability skills and enhance knowledge of labour market information whilst providing them with the access to all career pathways. We had a wonderful lunch prepared by students there.



My BM UK Trip

"CLAP for Youth @ JC" (CLAP) is Hong Kong's first crosssectoral support platform that helps students and nonengaged youth navigate their futures. This programme will develop an evidencebased intervention model, professional career and life planning teams, a onestop e-portal and parent and employer engagement - all to foster an enabling environment to create a new paradigm with a new discourse on work, success and talent match. Our school has joined the programme and has been one of the network schools since 2015.

This year, our school has been invited to join the advanced stage of the programme, i.e. "CLAP HK Benchmark" Pilot Scheme. This is a challenging scheme as we have to work towards the ten Hong Kong Benchmarks. We career teachers believe that by meeting the benchmarks, we can prepare young people for the opportunities, responsibilities and experiences of later life.

The highlight of the BM scheme was the UK trip last December. We received an intensive career training in Newcastle. The most impressive part of the trip was the school visits. We visited three schools in Newcastle. The school mission of Walker Riverside Academy is to consistently support and engage every individual student to understand and develop their own future pathway. In the sharing session, they mentioned that they have a close network with different working sectors. They integrate working opportunities into the school curriculum. Students have chances to experience work during school days, and they can know more about themselves and explore their potentials through the job tasting.

In Walker Riverside Academy, it is an inclusive community that believes in maintaining strong partnerships with parents and students to ensure that their learners thrive in a secure and stimulating environment. In their sharing, I was impressed by their teaching passion, and they stressed that every student is valued and respected. In school, it is designed like a small community with high-quality facilities and equipment. I remember I have visited a room which was designed like a salon and students can practice hairdressing there. This makes learning more interesting and experiential.

To conclude, I have gained lots of insights in career guidance. I wish I can make use of what I have learnt and work towards the benchmarks.

A dream is never too big

The term "Career Planning", or "Life Planning" has been a buzzword in recent years within the education sector. Teachers need to guide students to a path leading to a career that is suitable for them. Most students in this year and age do not have a concrete idea of what they are interested in, not to mention a career they should aim for in the future. So, how?

It is where HKBM comes in and offers me an answer.

In HKBM, there are clear statements of what good career guidance should look like. It is broadly evidence-based and commands an exceptional level of support from all stakeholders. I have never had this level of clarity and agreement about what I am trying to achieve through Career and Life Planning (CLP).

"A dream is never too big." I was in awe when I heard this from one of the speakers. The statement expresses the aspiration of everything being possible with a meticulous and persevering attitude. The statement also reminds me of my ethical compass when my doing careers and guidance education. Dreams are the basis of our life, and nothing is impossible when genuine dreams are big aspirations. In the face of adversity, be it teachers or students, one may get discouraged, but we need to bear in mind that the course that gets you from where you are to our desired goals may take twists and turns. Success is not always a straight line. We will eventually get there with persistence and attitude.

The training and HKBM provide teachers with a clear sense of what we are trying to achieve and what needs to be done next. I believe that this radical evolution offers the best way to accomplish the aspiration that everyone in this

space shares for young people to have access to high-quality career guidance.

St. Peter's is a school with a careers and guidance system supported by passionate and enthusiastic organizations like HKJC where teachers and students are given chances to get acquainted with exploring themselves to the many opportunities not only to dream but to attain their goals. We are after all in the driver's seat of our life. Will there be a dream too big?

3D 筆工作坊

(一) 3D筆工作坊

去年10月,我們舉辦了3D筆工作坊,讓同學利用3D筆將書本抽象的名詞(如:DNA)製成模型,並於開放日展示成果,給大家欣賞。

(二)火箭車同樂日

今年1月,我們在校舉行了首屆校內中二級火箭車比賽。同學們組成小隊,一起利用環保物料和學過的 科學原理,設計出一輛輛獨一無二的火箭車,在跑道上飛馳。

(三)科展比賽

今年4月,四位對STEM充滿熱誠的同學──本人(黃子軒)、陳昊天、胡樂熙和袁浩瑋,組成了一個小隊,代表學校參加第五十三屆聯校科學展覽,並取得報告書設計比賽的全港亞軍。

本次科展的主題是「工作場所」。再三斟酌之後,我們決定以安全性為一個切入點,來設計我們的參 展作品。

火箭車同樂日



花了好幾個月的時間不斷收集資料和觀察,終讓我們想到了一個名為Posture Observation and Correction System (P.O.C.S.)的系統並應用於貨倉中。這系統利用科技減少工人因搬運姿勢不正確而出現的工傷意外,僱主也可省卻因工傷而作出的賠償及犧牲之生產力,達雙贏的局面。

系統以人面識別技術偵察及辨別搬運工人身分,然 後透過工作背心上安裝的陀

螺儀及二維碼作雙重檢測,判斷其抬舉姿勢是否正確。如有問題,則以提示燈及蜂鳴器提醒,同時以物聯網(IoT)技術紀錄相關數據,讓僱主作後期分析,並以此作員工職安健評核準則之一。

我們希望可以在親手實現想法時,學到一些實用的經驗。今次比賽正值停課,整個擬定計劃書透過Zoom、WhatApp及Googledrive,以線上模式運作,這種體驗確是難忘,亦側面揭示出創意解難之重要。

可能我們現時的技術水平不高,亦有可能我們太過理想化,設計在現實中會面臨失敗,更有可能我們不得不向現實的限制低頭。但科技融合生活的種子已經在我們的心中種下,日後終將成長成參天大樹。




